**Eastern Indiana Regional Workforce Board
Announces Contract Award to JobWorks, Inc.**

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Barbara Street, Regional Operator for the Eastern Indiana Regional Workforce Board, announced the award of a two year contract for services through the WorkOne Centers in Blackford, Delaware, Fayette, Henry, Jay, Randolph, Rush, Union and Wayne counties to JobWorks, Inc.

The primary contractual responsibility of JobWorks is to provide staffing support for the eight WorkOne offices located in Eastern Indiana and designated by the State of Indiana as Economic Growth Region 6. However, the Workforce Board also expects JobWorks to provide fiscal reporting, and payment of vendor costs associated with customer training. The contract award is expected to cover a two year period and projected to total over 6 million dollars.

JobWorks is a Fort Wayne based Indiana not for profit firm contracted to provide services in several Indiana regions and outside of Indiana in Ohio and California. JobWorks is headed by Steve Corona, President & CEO.

Eastern Indiana Regional Workforce Board is provided funding from the Indiana Department of Workforce Development to manage the workforce and economic

development services for Economic Growth Region 6 (EGR 6). Customer services are provided through eight WorkOne offices throughout EGR 6 which consists of Blackford, Delaware, Fayette, Henry, Jay, Randolph, Rush, Union, and Wayne counties. These customer services are provided by various partnership agencies which make up the WorkOne system. Indiana Department of Workforce Development is the cognizant state agency for the WorkOne system in the state of Indiana.
